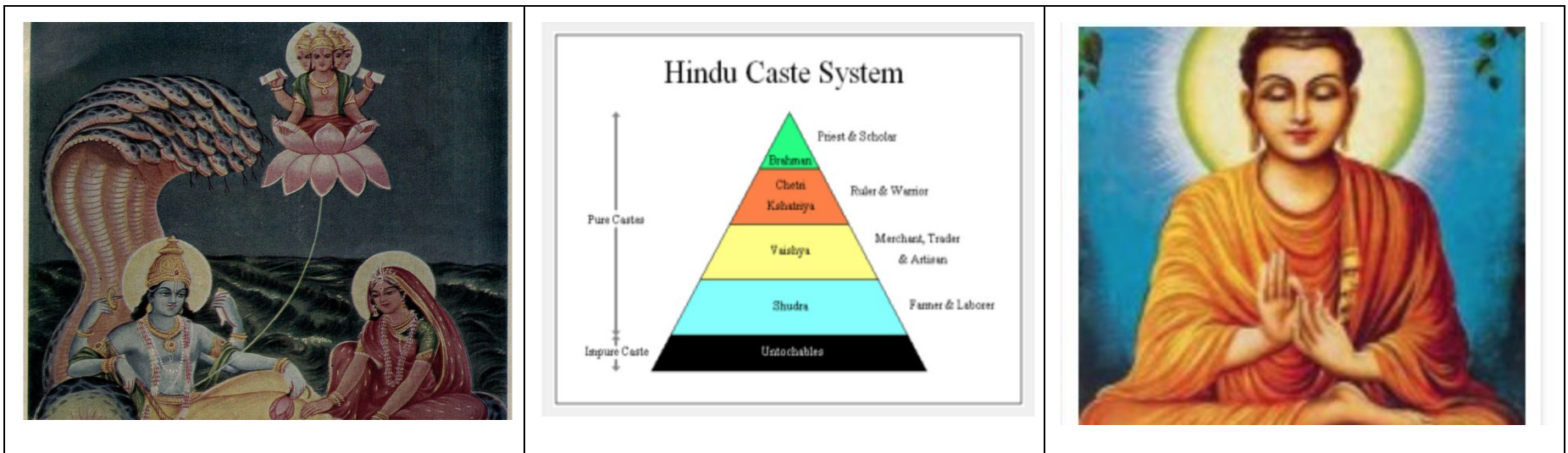

# Wk.7 Science: How do animals reproduce?

## 1. Live birth

○Live birth – the baby is born from the mother's body

## 2. Eggs

○Eggs – the young are cocooned in a shell outside of the mother until birth

## 3. Fragmentation

○Fragmentation – the parent organism breaks into individual pieces and each piece becomes an adult.
