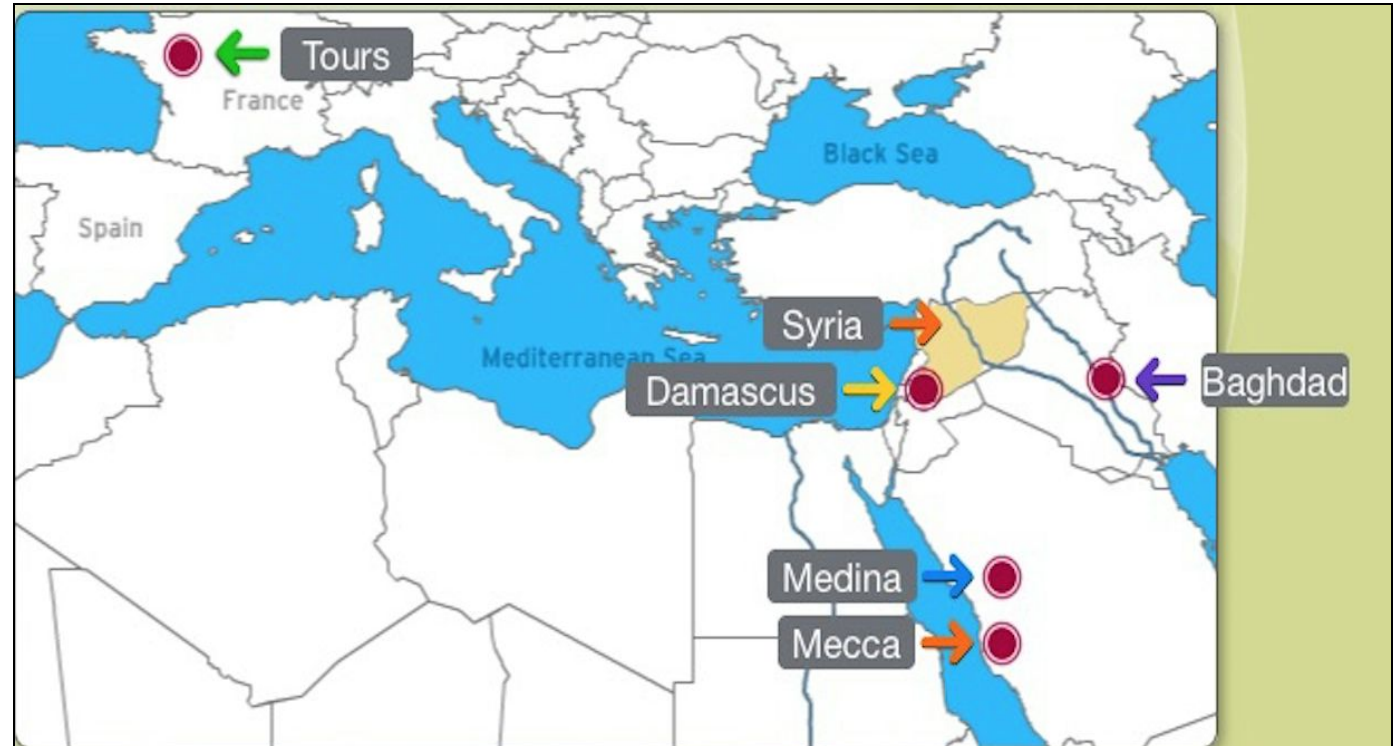

2 tablespoons (Tbsp.)=1 fluid ounce (fl. oz)
